



2010 TSQHA SUMMER CELEBRATION CIRCUIT RULES

June 10–13, 2010

Must show to all 4 Judges

Points will accumulate on the horse in the open classes.

Small Fry and Lead line points will accumulate during the circuit.

Awards will be awarded in each class as a class champion by the most points accumulated by horse and rider.

To be eligible for a circuit award all horses must participate in their respective halter class to all 4 judges. This includes all Open, Amateur, Novice, Select, and Youth exhibitors.

Grand & Reserve points will only be counted in a tied high point halter class. If the tie cannot be broke by Grands & Reserves (Grands 1pt. & Reserves 1/2pt.) it will then be decided by the tiebreaker judge.

High Points will be awarded to Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, Select Amateur, 13 & under Youth, 14-18 Youth, Amateur, Open, High point Halter Stallion, Mare & Gelding.

You must have 3 categories to be an All-Around. The points in all classes will be added to the total All-Arounds. (AQHA Rules by categories)

Class championship tiebreaker will be broken by who has the most 1st, 2nd and 3rd and so on. If a tie is not broken, the judge of the day will make the final decision.

One Work Saddle is to be given away by drawing to a 2010 TSQHA member showing at the Summer Celebration. You may join TSQHA before the lunch break on Day 1 of the Celebration.

One Hunt Saddle donated by Village Tack is to be given away by drawing to a 2010 TSQHA member showing at the Summer Celebration. You may join TSQHA before the lunch break on Day 1 of the Celebration.

TSQHA members showing at the Summer Celebration are eligible for both drawings.

Both drawings to be held the Saturday of the Celebration at approximately noon.
