

## TSQHA POINT NOMINATION RULES

- 1. Point nominations are valid only after association dues have been paid.
- 2. A nomination form must be filled out, with proper fees enclosed and mailed out to the designated person as stipulated on the form.
- 3. Nominations must be postmarked prior to the date of the first show in which points are to be tabulated. Nominations post marked the date of a particular show will not be accepted for that show but will be tabulated for all subsequent shows.
- 4. At a show, nominations can only be accepted by the **TSQHA Point Secretary**, and must be turned in prior to the showing of the exhibitor's first class of the day for points to count for that show.
- 5. Only points earned at TSQHA and TSQHA approved shows will count, and no points will count until both membership and nomination fees have been paid.
- 6. It will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor or owner to provide documented proof of payment of dues and nomination fees, if requested to validate any discrepancies.
- 7. Year end awards are given **first to third places** and only to horses earning a minimum of fifteen (15) points in a given class AND HORSES SHOWING 6 TSQHA SHOWS/6 JUDGES.

## AWARDS GIVEN

- 1. All halter and performance classes as shown on the TSQHA-sponsored show bill.
- 2. ALL AROUND and RESERVE ALL AROUND in Open, Amateur, Select, Youth 14-18, Youth
  - 13 and Under.
- 3. GRAND and RESERVE CHAMPIONS in each sex division of Halter (combined age divisions).
- 4. HIGH POINT and RESERVE HIGH POINT Novice Amateur and Novice Youth.
- 5. HIGH POINT and RESERVE HIGH POINT Small-Fry
- 9. All ties will be broken according to the TSQHA By-Laws, Article IX, Section 4.
- 10. Points will only be awarded to nominated horses. Points will follow the horse, not the rider, with the exception of Lead Line and Small Fry Exhibitors. Points shall be based on the rider alone for the Lead Line and Small Fry Divisions. Lead Line and Small Fry Exhibitors need to be nominated, not the horse.
- 11. All TSQHA association-held shows are **triple pointed**.
- 12. In the event the Select and Amateur classes are combined, then the exhibitor would get the points posted to the SELECT division (based on total number of entries in the class). In the event the classes were NOT combined and an exhibitor elects to show in the Amateur class, then the points would post to the Amateur Division.

For all non-select classes (like halter, western riding, hunter hack, etc.), the points would be posted to the Amateur Division.
